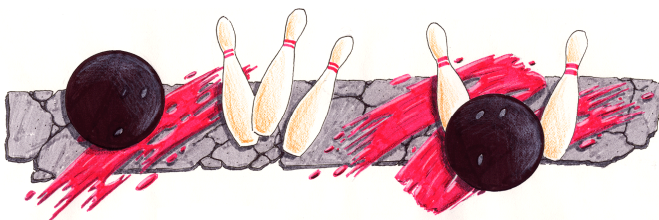

## **Loving takes August PIBC Tournament**

James Loving notched his second Parris Island Bowling Club championship with a resounding 246-172 thumping of Hawk Lewis at Ribaut Lanes on August 8th from a small field of 22 entries. Lewis was the top qualifier for the day at 663 and waited patiently in the wings for the finals as the other qualifiers battled for the right to advance.

Loving, who topped the second shift at 662, was joined by Tom Yuhas (659) and Bill Jackson (653), along with new club member Bill Allen (566), the high scratch non-qualifier for the day, in the roll-off.

In the first match, Yuhas (182) advanced with a closely fought battle between Allen (181) and Jackson (175). Loving would then send Yuhas to the sidelines with a 236-177 victory to advance to the title match against Lewis.

Loving was off and running in the finals with a double to start the match while Lewis seemed to have suffered from the long wait and never got his game going. By the fifth frame, Lewis had his second open frame and the match was virtually over at that point as Loving had a 32 pin lead. Loving tacked on a double for good measure going into the seventh frame to extend his lead to 45 pins and it was just a matter of how large the final margin of victory would be. He closed the match with a turkey for the 246-172 victory to add his second PIBC title to his bowling career.

Loving and Lewis combined for a 831 to capture the first shift Mystery Doubles and then Loving joined with Bill Jackson for 853 to take the second shift honors with Ron Culberson & Jay Lovell in second at 827.

The next tournament will be held on October 10th at Parris Island Lanes. The renovations at Hunter Lanes will not be completed for use this year, therefore PI Lanes will have host the next tournament, along with the year end event on December 12th. Bring your friends and come join the fun.
